

## National Security (JROTC)

Working for Uncle Sam can mean being a mail carrier, or it could mean being the President of the United States. But no matter where on the spectrum a government job falls, it always involves serving the public and working to help the government make life better for Americans.

State government posts offer a fair number of managerial and professional positions, with local government jobs offering more openings for service workers. Excluding education and hospitals, state and local governments employ about 7.5 million people, making them among the largest employers in the country. These jobs are expected to grow 12 percent during the next decade.

Another option within this cluster is a career in the U.S. military. The military is charged with protecting the United States of America, and protecting the interests of the U.S. worldwide. By joining the U.S. military you will be part of that effort.
